Practical Life Tidbits

5 Grilling Safety Tips



Thousands of fires are caused by outdoor grills each year. That doesn't mean you have to scrap your barbeques. Here are some tips to help keep you safe.

1. Most people know that hairspray is flammable, but you should also be careful when applying other sprayed on products such as insecticides and sunscreen. You should wait several minutes to allow the alcohol in these products time to evaporate before going near your grill or any other open flame.
2. Be sure that your grill is in an open space away from your home and anything that may melt or catch fire (such as tree branches). There have been many cases of people catching their wood siding on fire or melting their vinyl siding.
3. Never grill in your garage. Most people store some type of flammable and combustible items in their garage and this could lead to an explosion.
4. Clean your grill often to eliminate grease from the grates and trays. Also check for leaks in your gas grill on a regular basis.
5. Never leave a grill unattended and keep children and pets away. Always keep a fire extinguisher near your grill just in case.
