Prescription Drug Misuse Is A BIG PROBLEM



- According to the Centers for Disease Control, prescription drug abuse has led to more deaths than drunk driving.
- 20% of Indiana Teens report using medications to get high.
-The drugs most commonly used by teen include: over the counter medicines like cough syrup and sinus medicines, as well as prescribed pain relievers, stimulants, and depressants.
- Drugs are even falling into the hands of our toddlers and pets.
-In 2013, over 12,000 Marion County toddlers, 5 and under were treated for drug exposure.
